Work continues on repairing damages associated with the flooding which occurred in December, 2022 due to frozen/burst water pipes in the newest section of the church. New ceilings are being replaced in both the men's and women's rest rooms. Please excuse us until this is completed. This should be completed before mid-June.

We have recently enhanced our security and safety efforts in and around our church. New locks have been placed on all entry and exit doors of our facilities. We now have a combination of keyed and keyless entry/exit. We also have nine cameras installed and operational in and around the facilities. These cameras are equipped with both audio and video capabilities. They also have playback ability in the event of potential security breaches to our facilities.

These measures will provide us with enhanced means by which to ensure our protection and that of our facilities .
