If you would like to support this outreach ministry, you can either pack a food box for a family of 4 or you can simply donate items that we can use to pack boxes. We will be collecting all non-perishable items at our November Fellowship Wednesday the evening of Wednesday, November 8th. Here is a list of items needed for the boxes:
