A Review from the Pastor and Church Council Chair

Shiloh's Church Council approved Jerry Green and Rev. John to make an update on the church's successes and challenges. We have so much to be proud of here at Shiloh, as well as many opportunities for the future! Our council adopted a motto for 2024: "to bring others to God in this place and time, help others gain a mature faith in God, maintain focus on guiding and developing disciples of Jesus Christ, and seeking God's will and the Holy Spirit's Guidance in all that we do."

In that spirit, here is some of the progress we have witnessed in the church lately:

- We have started a technology committee to see to the needs of the church.
- We are also looking for ways to make our resources and buildings available to the community (please feel free to give us suggestions!).
- We also need to thank Mrs. Clyde Sanders for leading the painting project for the fellowship hall and kitchen!
- Our Evangelism Committee has revamped our outreach material in the form of a new bifold brochure and have plans to distribute it in the community.
- Our Family Ministries team has planned out monthly events since the Fall going into the present.
- Our Childrens and Youth ministries have continued on strong and will now be strengthened further by our newly hired coordinator Catie Fryfogle.
- We have hired Constance Flemming on as our official pianist/organist and choir director.
- Our United Methodist Men and United Women in Faith have been meeting regularly and seeking to increase their participation.
- The loan for our last major expansion has been paid off! The faithful giving we've seen has seen 400k get repaid in such a short time!
- But we also have challenges in this new year! So please pray on these issues and give us any advice you can:
- Shiloh's team for a new strategic plan is meeting soon to shape our long-term goals.
- We need more volunteers with children's church, Sunday School, and our SPRC is looking to hire a part time nursery worker.
- Developing our activities for children under 15.
- Paying off the loan for our basement flood damage.
- Expanding our choir. And our 2024 budget is \$283,934 with a weekly budget need of \$5,160 - Jerry Green and Pastor John Kronz
