#### A Review from the Pastor and Church Council Chair

Our Church Council approved Rev. John and Jerry Green to give an update on the Church's successes and challenges. We have so much to be proud of here at Shiloh, as well as opportunities for the future! Our council adopted the motto for 2024 "to bring others to God in this place and time, help others gain a mature faith in God, maintain focus on guiding and developing disciples of Jesus Christ, and seeking God's will and the Holy Spirit's guidance in all that we do."

In that spirit, here is some of the progress we have witnessed at Shiloh;

- Our technology committee and Trustees are planning improvements to our sound systems this summer, and looking into a new digital sign.
- Our family ministries team has continued monthly Wednesday night suppers and other events for fellowship and family fun.

- Our children and youth ministry is continuing on strong under the direction of Catie
  Fryfogle, with an average 7 youth in attendance at Raise Youth and Energize Kids well
  underway.
- VBS planning is going strong with robust volunteer commitments, and we are set up for perhaps our largest ever VBS event at Shiloh.
- We also celebrate the hiring of our new nursery worker Mrs. Stephanie Cook-Smith.
- Mrs. Constance continues to be a blessing as a musical director and has worked with our children to perform for Mother's day and Father's day.
- The faithful giving of Shiloh members has led us to finish paying off our 400K building loan several years early, and we are on track to pay off our 25K Small Business Administration loan this summer.
- A fire pit has been added behind the church facilities for the use of our youth and for other gatherings.
- In our search for ways to make our facility available to the community we are getting to host a program to helping girls ages 11-14.
- Research has begun into adding a cremation vault to our cemetery.

While there is much to be excited about, we do also have challenges:

- Our strategic plan is being finalized and we look to each committee to meet and give
  us their objectives for the future.
- We are always in need of more volunteers for our children and youth.
- Anyone with confidence in singing is welcome to join our choir.
- Our 2024 budget is \$283,936 with a weekly budget need of \$5,160
