Missions & Outreach

Gilbert Middle School - We are very low in healthy snacks for GMS. We collect Goldfish crackers, peanut butter crackers, cheese crackers, granola bars, protein bars, trail mix, boxes of raisins, etc.

Glasses for Guatemala - We are once again collecting used eyeglasses, readers, sunglasses and eyeglass cases for needy people in Guatemala. Partnering with the Lions Club which polishes and refurbishes these glasses and delivers them to people in need in rural communities in Guatemala. We have a collection basket on the cabinet between the fellowship hall and the double glass doors. 
